## School Description

Calvary Murrieta Christian Schools is a private school partnering with Christian families, offering a challenging education for preschool through twelfth grade that is grounded and shaped by Christian values and perspectives. Our junior high and high schools are accredited by the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) and by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC).

Originally founded in 1993, the school is a ministry of Calvary Chapel Murrieta. Admission to the school is based on a personal interview and, depending on the grade level, will include entrance test scores, recommendation letters, and previous school records. In addition, enrollment to the elementary and secondary schools requires that the student (if enrolling in junior or senior high) and at least one parent have made a profession of faith in Jesus Christ and maintain regular church attendance.

The school is located in Murrieta, California, a fast growing community with a population in excess of 100,000. The student body represents the diversity of the city and the surrounding Temecula Valley. The class of 2011 will be the thirteenth graduating class of Calvary Murrieta Christian Schools.
