



**Calvary Murrieta Christian Schools
Computer/Internet Acceptable Use Policy
2018-2019 School Year**

Calvary Murrieta Christian Schools (CMCS) provide the use of computer facilities and Internet access for educational use only. For the students to use the Internet, parents must give their permission. Please review these guidelines with your student and indicate your permission for him/her to use the Internet.

1. Use the computer and Internet only with your teacher's permission and for the purpose your teacher has requested.
2. Your school computer files are not private and your teacher or system manager may see them at any time.
3. Do not attach devices such as cell phones, MP3 players, iPods, or flash drives to any computer without teacher permission.
4. Respect copyright laws: Do not copy materials without permission. Be sure to tell where you found your information.
5. Do not enter information about yourself on any online forms.
6. Do not agree to meet anyone in person that you have met online.
7. Do not attempt to access profane or obscene material. If you do so, accidentally, notify your teacher right away.
8. Do not enter inappropriate or hurtful language into the computer.
9. Students will be disciplined per the general disciplinary practices if they do not follow these guidelines or if they utilize the computers and Internet inappropriately.

Teleconferencing

Calvary Murrieta Christian Schools are involved in several innovative technology programs, including the use of teleconferencing equipment. This equipment allows students and teachers to communicate with students and teachers in other schools in our city, our nation, and other countries. Students may also take virtual tours of museums and other places of interest! Your student may have an opportunity to participate in one or more of these telecommunications programs throughout the year. We need your permission to allow them to do so.

Student Art Work or Writing

It is the policy of Calvary Murrieta Christian Schools that a student's artwork or writing may be published on a web page developed for educational purposes with parental permission. Such published work will be identified by student's initials only.

The work will appear with a copyright notice prohibiting the copying of such work without written permission of the parent/guardian. In the event, anyone requests permission, that request will be forwarded to the parent/guardian for permission.

BYOD (Bring Your Own Device)

The use of portable electronic devices in the classroom can add educational value when such devices deliver content and extend, enhance or reinforce the student learning process. Classroom teachers determine the appropriateness of in-class use of electronic devices, consistent with school instructional objectives, and with approval of the school principal.

All personal electronic devices must be used in a responsible, and legal manner. Students are permitted to bring and use approved personal electronic devices for educational purposes **under** the direction of a classroom teacher. CMCS is not responsible for the loss or theft of a device, nor responsible for any damage done to the device while at school.
